Your new puppy's arrival at home will be a great moment. Golden Retrievers are the most devoted dogs to humans. Yours is born from parents who have great qualities as they have been reproduced for and for which this breed exists. Faithful companions, their trainability et learning capacities turns them into great retrievers for hunting and excellent competitors in different canine trials and tests.

Your puppy is the result of two adults in good health bred together and who have great dispositions, even over certain standards. They are recognised for having a steady temperament and sociable attitude. Those elements make are the basic structure of your puppy, but they have to be encouraged into an adequate education and supported with all your love for this new family member. The basic obedience course is strongly recommended if it is available in your area because it is as important as school for a child. Our main goal with this recommendation is to encourage you to develop your relationship with your dog and, for your puppy, to become a valuable and appreciated member of your family.

By the present agreement, I _____, reserve a puppy from the next available litter, according to the following terms and conditions :

A specific contract will be delivered with each puppy sold.

The sum of 300,00\$ per puppy will be given to the seller, in attestation of the reservation, the day the pregnancy is confirmed. The sum of 800,00\$ per puppy reserved will be given to the seller the day of his delivery. For a non respected agreement from the buyer , the seller will claim a fee of 300,00\$.

Terms and conditions of the sale agreement.

The sale price per puppy is 1100,00\$. It is divided as follow : 300,00\$ deposit for reservation, 800,00\$ at delivery. In addition, at delivery, a 100,00\$ refundable deposit for obedience courses will be asked. This 100,00\$ deposit will be refunded when the puppy will have completed his obedience course (written proof of completion needed). This deposit does not apply if no obedience courses are available in your area.

The obedience course should be started before the puppy is eight (8) months old. This will help his socialization, pack hierarchy, development of his skills and assure his safety and self confidence. Because the dog is naturally a pack member, you will develop the "Alpha" status as a leader. This status means security, stability and discipline to the dog. These elements well developed into obedience courses will help you develop great relationship with your dog companion.

Shipping arrangements can be made with the seller.

The Golden Retriever puppy described before has been examined by a certified veterinarian and has been recognized to be in good health. He has received his first vaccines shots and parasites shots.

The puppy has to be examined by your certified veterinary within 72 hours from reception. We certify that the puppy has been sold in good health. If he has to be returned because of disease, a letter from the veterinarian explaining the diagnostic is needed.

The litter from which the puppy is from has been registered to Canadian Kennel Club (CKC). This registration declares the existence of those puppies. For your own puppy's identification and registration, you must do a specific registration as an individual dog (the needed documents can be provided by the seller). Your dog's registered name at the CKC, other than the casual name given at home, must contain the word ZOMARICK. The same terms apply to any other registrations done in all the different Canine clubs and associations in the world (like AKC, UKC, etc.).

Your dog's registration will have the « no breeding » condition, unless a specific term applies between the buyer and the seller.

Every time your dog wins titles during his life, the buyer will keep the seller informed about them (titles from AKC, UKC, CKC, GRCA, GRCC or NAHRA, for example).

That Buyer guarantees Seller right of first refusal if the dog is to be sold or disposed of in any way. If Seller does not wish to acquire dog, Seller may assist Buyer in placing him.

Your puppy is the result of a breeding program that considers physical and temperament qualities. Your dog will accomplish many tasks for you in his life. Because it is a living animal, we do not guaranty him for any accidents, abuses or environmental factors.

Your dog will be guaranteed until 26 months of age for any genetic failure. To fulfill guaranty requirements, the recognized tests have to be done between the age of 23 and 26 months old, age which the puppy is fully grown. This guaranty covers the replacement of the dog by another one, of the same gender, from a next litter from the seller. The buyer must provide the seller all tests results. If tests are done after the age of 26 months, the guaranty doesn't apply.
